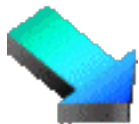

UNION ACTS ON SERIOUS ONGOING SAFETY CONCERNS WITH WASTE COLLECTION PRACTICES AT CITY OF PERTH

Despite ongoing concerns having been raised by our members and job delegates who work in Waste Services over recent years at the City of Perth, the Council has persisted in sending and/or allowing both day and night shift crews to go out with only two (2) workers on the rubbish collection vehicles.

This practice forces the driver to constantly get in and out of the vehicle to assist the swamper in the collection of the rubbish.

As recently as mid to late 2016 a member had lodged a detailed concern about this practice and sought a permanent rule that all trucks be staffed by 3 workers. Management dismissed this concern.

On Monday morning the 16th of January 2017, one of the drivers from the Waste Services Section was hit by a motor vehicle just after getting out his truck to assist his swamper.

Tragically he passed away some days later due to the nature of injuries caused by the collision.

This matter is now the subject of a Work Safe Investigation as there have been three (2) related deaths involving this service in the past six (6) years.

In response to this, the Union's Executive Committee of Management, and Meeting of General members on the 13th of February 2017 has authorised the Union's Workers Compensation Solicitor, Rebecca Sorgiovanni to assist in the preparation of witness statements from members who work in this section to be lodged both with Work Safe and the Coroner.

It is our sincere hope that the Authorities will listen as management have not been listening
