Conditions

- A) Access and unimpeded passage to be given to all emergency vehicles
- B) All danger points and intersections to be manned by responsible adult marshals.
- C) Precautions to be taken to ensure the safety of all participants and members of the public, with assistance from sufficient marshals wearing reflective vests/clothing.
- D) There will be no intrusion onto or into any private property without the prior permission of the owners/occupiers thereof.
- E) To run/walk on Footpaths/Principal Shared Paths. Where no footways are provided and road verges are untrafficable, Participants will travel by vehicle.
- F) Check and rest points are to be manned by responsible adult persons, and are to be established well clear of footways or carriageways.
- G) Each pilot vehicle front and rear to have appropriate signs and warning lights (Walkers Ahead/Behind). Minimum of two escort vehicles. One in front, one behind.
- H) To cycle on dual use paths where provided or on the extreme left side of the carriageway, no more than two abreast.
- I) All participants and officials are to comply with the provisions of the Road Traffic Act and Regulations.
- J) Participants in the parade formation to be no more than four abreast/band five.
- K) The playing of musical instruments or the use of amplifiers shall be subject to the approval of the local authority.
- L) No Person will carry, display or use any banners or placards which are substantially constructed of wood, iron or similar substance or of such dimensions that they are likely to be a danger or cause interference to other persons.
- M) Participants are not to obstruct the free passage of other persons or prevent access to and egress from premises.
- N) No persons to encroach onto the road carriageway.
- O) No persons shall board or alight from any participating vehicle once the parade has commenced.
- P) No materials to be used on the vehicles to obscure a driver's vision, the lighting or registration plates.
- Q) No driver of any support vehicle shall drive continuously beyond twelve hours without taking a six hour rest.
- R) No pedestrians to walk along road carriageway unless escorted by police OR adequate approved traffic management infrastructure is provided to ensure the safety of participants and other members of the public.
- S) For all events involving 'mass gatherings', event organisers are to consult the National Security website: www.nationalsecurity.gov.au (Displays a list of strategies for Protecting Crowded Places from Terrorism).


